# President's Message

#### Dear NARI Members:

We have been working hard since our last newsletter in December on many things that will benefit our NARI of Idaho members. This includes several great trainings and event (see page 5), our Home Tour (see page 6) but there is more!!

NARI has been working for over a year with the Department of Labor to develop an apprenticeship program through WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT. We are happy to announce that we have been approved for a grant to begin a two year carpenter training program that will be available to NARI members only! Below are some of the details:

- NARI will conduct a week long "Boot Camp" in late summer for young adults interested in the construction
- Beginning in the Fall, NARI members can take on an apprentice. The apprentice will work fulltime for the remodeler while taking 3 hours of class each week. The curriculum over two years runs from business to skills training in all phases of a remodeling job.
- The first six months of their salary will be matched 50% by the Department of Labor (and possibly more if the apprentice meets certain qualifications such as being a veteran)
- There is a two year commitment but with an escape clause if the relationship is not working.

More information will be coming out in the next few weeks. We will be looking for trainers, apprenticeship slots, and most important, your input.

We need to keep up the momentum! We are always looking for Committee Chairs to help advance the many programs we have coming up (see page 7). If you have any ideas, comments or even criticisms you want to bring to the board, give me a shout. We are listening to you! Remember, always use a NARI member to help you accomplish your remodel.

### **CODE UPDATES**

# 2018 Legislative Session:

This past session was an interesting one for codes. House Bill 547 was introduced and sought to make it impossible for cities and counties to amend codes to meet local circumstances. After much pressure from groups like NARI the final bill was amended to only apply to residential codes and to allow for amendments of design standards, administrative standards and such, with all other amendments allowed if they addressed building or health safety. Thanks to those members who sent emails and letters to their legislative members or who showed up to testify!

On January 1, 2018 new code updates will be going into effect:

2015 International Building Code (January 1, 2018)

2015 International Existing Building Code (January 1, 2018)

2015 Idaho (Uniform) Plumbing Code (July 1, 2017)

2015 IECC with 2012 amendments for Residential portion (January 1, 2018)

2015 Idaho Fire Code (March 29, 2017)

2017 National Electrical Code (January 1, 2018)

Codes that were not updated at the state level were:

2012 Idaho Residential Code (Note that Boise and other cities adopted the 2105 version of this code—check with the jurisdiction you are working in)

2012 Fuel and Gas Code

2012 Mechanical Code

Please note that some cities and counties are moving forward and adopting the 2015 IRC and full 2015 IECC. Check with your jurisdiction to see what they are doing.

## Safety Notes From Joe Levitch, Safety Committee Chair

#### Safety Moment- Hydration

It is the hydration season again. I had an employee arrive after work to return the truck. He was pale and not sweating somewhat confused. I cornered him and asked how much he had been drinking and if he had been peeing regularly. He was defiantly dehydrated. I made him drink a quart of water on the spot. The rule is that if your pee is dark or concentrated that you are not drinking enough. Your pee should be nearly clear to stay safe on these hot days. Teach your team.

Gatorade and power drinks in general are too potent. Dilute them 50% and that will make a better concoction. In some states it is mandatory to have a water cooler on site. Let's stay ahead of the game and make sure our teams are taking care of themselves.
